1) The story takes place in 1942, over 60 years ago. However, in what ways is life in the annex similar to life today? Reread the disagreements and altercations between Anne and her mother. Refer to the relationships between the characters and how they interact. Think about how the actions of the characters are similar to the way young people (and their parents) interact today. Be sure to include specific examples from the text. Try to incorporate at least one cited piece of evidence from the text. Minimum 5 sentences.

2) At the beginning of Scene 5, the Hanukkah celebration begins. Both Mr. and Mrs. Frank lead prayers read aloud at length. What is the author's purpose for including such long biblical passage. Discuss why the author would include this in the dialogue. Additionally, explain the significance of Hanukkah to those living in the annex. Why is it important to carry on the tradition inside the annex? What does it mean to them? Minimum 3 sentences.
