Overview:

On September 24, 2013, the Governing Board discussed the Superintendent's recommendation to form a Local Control Advisory Committee. On October 8, 2013, the Governing Board approved the processes to receive applications and select committee members. Information on the committee and the application were shared with the community through various means. The deadline to apply was November 4, 2013. Twenty-eight applications were received by the deadline. Trustees received copies of the twenty-six applications from community members as well as two from high school students.

At tonight's meeting, each trustee will turn in a ballot selecting up to eight community members and one student. Ballots will be read and tabulated in public and the eight community members and one student will be selected by majority vote.

Minutes

Superintendent Ahmadi introduced the item and explained the process. She thanked all of those who applied (26 applicants) and noted the LCAC meetings are open meetings and anyone can attend. The meetings will be held the third Tuesday of every month from 6:00-8:00 p.m. and held at the District Office. Ms. Ahmadi added we will be sharing our process with other districts.
