

Abbott ISD Elementary Grading Policy (2nd-5th)

Correcting Work:

Students will be allowed an opportunity to make up or redo a class assignment or examination for which the student received a failing grade. The teacher will accept the grade earned on the corrected assignment up to a 70 based upon the score on the make-up assignment.

Daily Grades:

Daily grades are considered work done in class, homework assignments, and participation.

Grades Taken per Six Weeks:

In grades 2-5, each teacher will record a minimum of ten daily grades and two test grades per subject per six weeks in the core subjects.

Grade Weighting:

3rd-5th: Daily work is 50% and test grades are 50%. Grades are to reflect a student's relative mastery of each subject. Students are graded on independent work and tests completed at school. In grades 2-5, student's grades will be taken from daily work and assessments.

2nd: Daily grades and test grades will have the same value and will be averaged together.

Late Work:

10 points will be deducted each day up to three days for late work. Late work will be accepted in a reasonable amount of time, but may not earn a grade higher than a 70 if more than three days late. Any student who has late or missing work will be required to participate in homework intervention until work is complete.

Report Card Grade:

Students will receive the grade they earned on individual assignments in the grade book, the actual grade will be reported on progress reports, and the report card.
