I must say, this experience was the highlight of my summer and a grand way to start the school year. 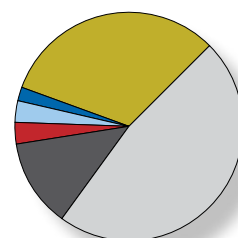

Gertrude Koch Winkenchbach '29

Faithful friend of St. Elizabeth Parish goes home

Proud graduate of Saint Elizabeth Elementary and High School, Gertrude Koch Winkenchbach, 102, went home to her eternal reward in June, 2013. Gertrude was born of German Catholic parents, Juliana and Bernard Koch, who arrived in the United States three years before her birth.

While at both Saint Elizabeth Elementary and High School, Gertrude's favorite teachers were Dominican Sisters Antonia, Claudia and Susanna. After her high school graduation, she was happy to work for several insurance companies in San Francisco, proud of holding jobs during the Depression.

Gertrude met her future husband at a "50-50 Dance" given at St. Elizabeth High. A Franciscan priest felt that Catholic young men and women never had opportunities to meet, so he organized 50 young women and 50 young men into an active social group. Gertrude and Wilfred "Wink" Winkenchbach became "an item" following an initial date that didn't seem too promising. "Wink" wanted to marry 3 months after they met, but Gertrude decided that 6 months would be more appropriate! "Wink", following the establishment of a successful tile business, became a limited partner in the Oakland Raiders and inventor of "Fantasy Football".



Because of their home at the time, Gertrude and "Wink" were active parishioners of St. Jarlath's Church, and the children, Gerald and Patty attended St. Jarlath's School. After completing their extensive education, Gerald married Nancy, and Patricia married Larry Wallace. Gertrude and "Wink" were proud of being grandparents of Corinne Green, and John Winkenchbach, and great grandparents of Tyler and Nathan Green and Avery Winkenchbach. They had many other relatives and a number of great friends. "Wink" preceded Gertrude in death.

An avid gardener, traveler and card player, Gertrude built many lasting friendships over her 102 years, and heaven must be filled with celebrations with those who loved her. May eternal rest be hers.

Sister Ellen Kelly, OP '48

Margaret Elizabeth Kelly went home to God May 4, 2013 after a life full of the challenge of providing top quality Catholic education to the children of the United States for 15 years and the children of Mexico for more than 40 years. The youngest of 3 children in an Irish Catholic family, she loved her brothers William and Michael, and was extremely proud of her family and their active involvement in the communication and transportation businesses.

Margaret graduated from Saint Elizabeth Elementary School and High School and became a Dominican Sister of Mission San Jose in 1949, taking the name "Ellen" after her mother.

Sister Ellen specialized early on teaching primary grades, but also taught junior high and became a vice-principal and principal along the way. In 1968 Sister was called to serve as principal of a bilingual parish school, College Junipero, Tacubuya, Mexico City, a school soon to be withdrawn from the care of the parish and transferred to a parent elected school board.

Managing a school in Mexico was certainly a challenge because of political and economic problems. Some of the difficulties included someone stealing the school's bonds, another group selling the school without anyone in the administration being aware! Members of the elected board worked very hard to raise the money to buy back the school.

Sister Ellen served God generously and loved life. She had a wonderful sense of humor and enjoyed a good joke. She was a rabid Notre Dame and 49er football fan!

She never turned away anyone who came to her for advice. She helped friends solve problems; she was a woman of faith and integrity, a true daughter of Saint Dominic.
