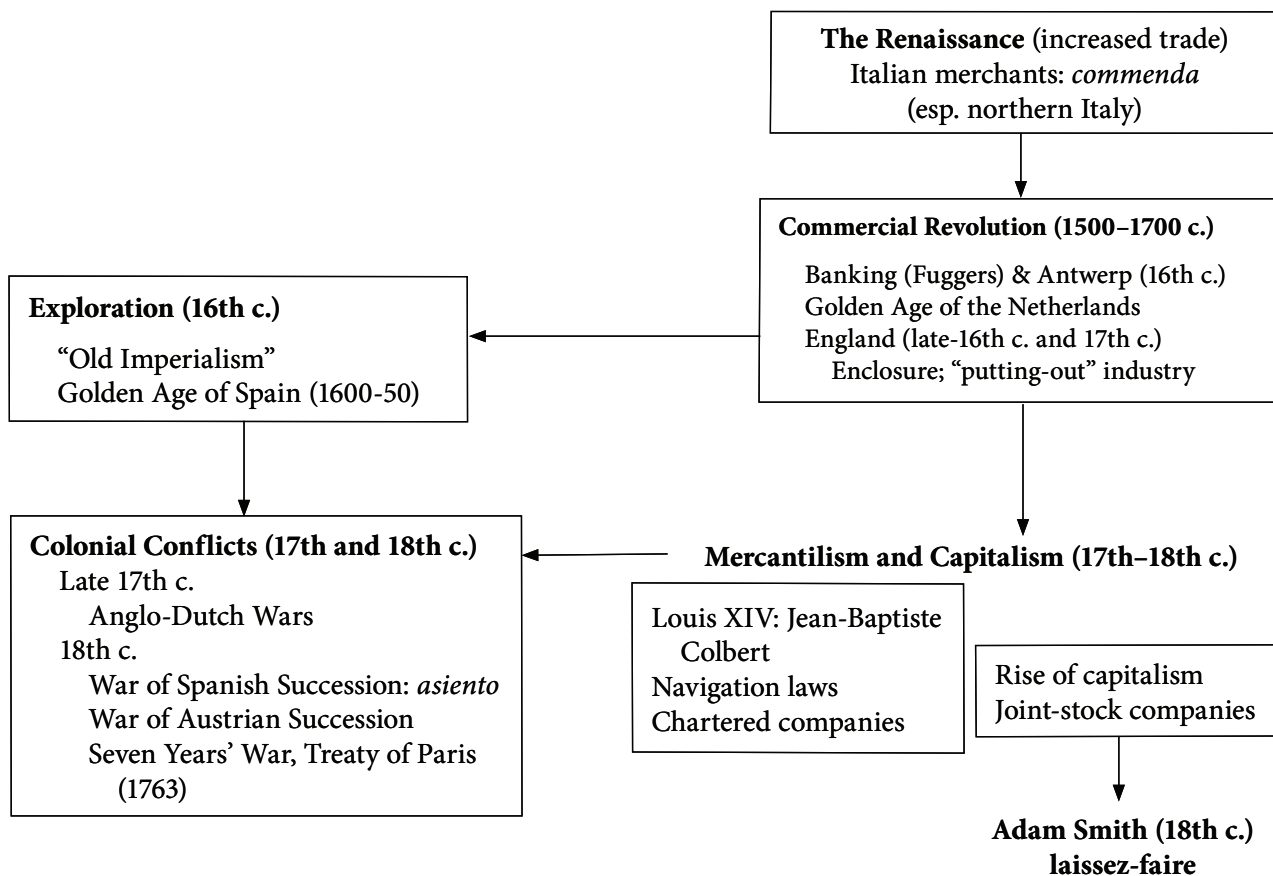


Economic Development Study Guide
