

Policy Implementation/Development of Regulations

The policies developed by the Board and the regulations developed to implement policy are designed to increase the probability of an effective and efficient school system. Consequently, it is assumed that all Board employees, students, and citizens will willingly carry them out.

The Board delegates to the Superintendent authority to develop, approve, and issue regulations and operating procedures necessary for the successful functions of the schools. The Board will officially approve only certain types of regulatory statements.

In the development or revision of regulations and operating procedures, the Superintendent will receive and consider suggestions from employees and other persons whom the regulation or operating procedure affects.

At the school level, principals together with their staffs will have the responsibility and authority to develop such rules and procedures as may be needed for effective school and classroom management and the implementation of Board policy and district regulations and procedures.
