- pencils, pens, paper, lead for mechanical pencils, notebooks (Most impactful)
- subscriptions to programs such as audible (website) so students can access books at home (Moderately impactful)
- printers, ink, computers, Internet access (Most impactful)
- wi-fi (especially at home since some teachers are forcing students to get material at home and they do not have Internet access at home) (Most impactful)
- No more flipping in classrooms - too confusing for EL students to learn things at home (Most impactful)
- specialized teachers pushing into the harder classes and helping at-risk students (Most impactful)
- food, snacks at school (Most impactful)
- teachers tutoring where students live (in apartment complexes or available to help online through chat) (Most impactful)
- case managers for EL students so they get the same type of specialized help that Resource students receive (Most impactful)
- family passes to museums if students lose their electives so they can appreciate the arts (Moderately impactful)
- field trips for students so they can learn outside of the classroom setting (Most impactful)
- rewards for students who do very well in school (at-risk students), some type of incentive program (Moderately impactful)
- bullying programs to support students (Most impactful)
- mandatory sensitivity training for teachers who have a history of failing at-risk students (Most impactful)
- food available on the weekends for students who are on free/reduced lunch (Moderately impactful)
- kill roaches in classrooms, it's distracting (Least impactful)
- writing programs at the middle school level (Most impactful)
- audio books students can check out at the library (Moderately impactful)
- glasses for children who can't afford it (Most impactful)
- adult education EL programs (Most impactful)
