MILWAUKEE COMMUNITY CYBER HIGH SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

Just as in a business where company policies related to dress and grooming are maintained, MC² High School has established its own policies. Each school day MC² High School students will uphold a professional image of our school and its members to the local business and surrounding communities. A student's dress and grooming should be clean, neat, and in good taste at all times. A student's appearance shall not create a distraction from or interfere with the normal orderly process of the instructional program or of the management of any part of the school program.

The following specific guidelines must be adhered to in the matter of dress at MC² High School:

1. All students will attire in school authorized polo shirts and plain, solid colored jeans or dress pants worn at the waist. Knee length or below skirts and shorts are also appropriate. Altered, slit, worn or frayed clothing is not acceptable.
2. All students will utilize school issued fleece jackets for comfort in the building. Other outerwear including jackets, hats, gloves, or hooded sweatshirts must be removed and stowed upon entry.
3. Athletic shoes, sandals, or dress shoes are appropriate. Slippers or house shoes are not.
4. Hairstyles and color must be appropriate for a professional setting. Shaved patterns or designs in hairstyles or eyebrows are not allowed.
5. Any additional apparel or accessories will be in professional good taste and not denote other related associations. Sunglasses, headgear such as scarves, rags, or bandanas, and chains or spiked/studded items are prohibited.

The Principal will make any final decision when a student's attire is questionable. Students/families will be offered a onetime correction to bring appropriate clothing or take the student home to change. Further violations will result in denied entrance to school until compliance is attained.
