

Your mission is to create a Roman Calendar in the style of a modern calendar.

Include the following:

- The 12 months in Latin
- Indicate the 7 days in the week in Latin
- Instead of numbers for the days, use Roman numerals—found in your dictionaries and the back of your yellow books
 - These should correspond to how many days are in each particular month
- Indicate on the calendar which days are the Calends, Nonnes, and the Ides of each month
- Include a written appointment for each month
 - an action (use an imperative)
 - Cena cum familia (eat dinner with family)
 - Use appropriate cases, grammar
 - **MUST BE A DIFFERENT ONE FOR EACH MONTH (12)—do not reuse appointments**
 - An appointment time for each appt. entry
 - Use ordinals (first, second, etc.) and the word “hora” in the ablative case i.e. *prima hora* (first hour)
- One Roman picture for each month—**should be based on a theme** (i.e. famous emperors, gods, gladiators, etc.)
 - Must be appropriate
 - You may draw, do a collage, or find a picture on the internet (please cite any pictures you borrow)
 - State your theme on the COVER—in Latin **and** English
- This may be drawn or done on the computer, however product must be neat, legible and professional (I suggest the computer for most of you)
- Bind calendar appropriately—please do not just staple
 - Use a report holder, go to kinkos, or staple and cover staples
 - It should open just like a modern calendar.
- **For a small amount of extra credit you may add appointments, or extras**
 - **Famous Roman dates, birthdays, holidays etc.**
- I can help you edit your Latin, but you must make an appointment with me and it may not be the week it is due.
