

LEGACY POINTS

Every student attending Bishop Ward High School is expected to participate in earning Legacy points. Students must earn 32 points to graduate, at least 8 points per year.

Points will be awarded once thorough reflection has been completed in the journal and signed off on by the Cyclone Time teacher. Students will earn a yearly Pass/Fail grade for Legacy Points. To Pass (and be eligible for exam waivers), a student must: earn at least 4 Legacy points by Dec. 1, earn at least 4 Legacy points by May 1 (Apr. 1 for Seniors), and successfully complete the Legacy Presentation by May 1 (for Freshman and Sophomores).

Journals are due to campus ministry on December 1 and May 1 (April 1 for seniors).

How did you experience God in the people you encountered?

How has your worldview changed since serving? How do you see differently?

As a result of your service experience, what is something you want to make the effort to see, listen to, or do in the future?
