What language is this?

h) $4^2 - 3 \cdot 4 + (8 \div 2)^3$

Expression: mathematical sentence that has numbers, variables, and operations, and NO equal sign.

Simplify: break an expression down to its simplest form.

Operation: addition, subtraction, multiplication, division

Variable: a number that we don't know, or that can change.

Addition: add, sum, plus, and, more, with, increase,

Subtraction: take away, minus, difference, less than, decrease, subtract

Multiplication: times, by, multiply, product, exponent/powers, multiples

Division: divide, cut in half, split, into, quotient, over, fractions, numerator, denominator, divisor, dividend
