

Expectations for the revision for your essay about Scar or Simba:

- Make sure you have followed **all the criteria** in the Analytic Scale for the Archetype Essay about Either Scar or Simba.
- Write a transition sentence as the last sentence of body paragraph 1. If you have 3 body paragraphs, write a transition sentence at the end of body paragraph 2 as well.
- Write a conclusion sentence at the end of the last body paragraph. (Example from Allison and Mrs. Janik: Once Simba, the rightful king and Hero, reigns over the Prideland, Supernatural Intervention and Nature allow a quick transformation of this Wasteland to its former Haven). Do not use this exact sentence in your essay; it is an example.
- Add a vocabulary word or two in meaningful ways from the list that you received on Thursday.
- Write an original simile or metaphor in one of your body paragraphs.
- Do not double double space between paragraphs. See Page Layout and box to click.
- Use only present tense and present perfect tense verbs throughout your essay (unless you are quoting from the movie, and the line you are quoting is written in past tense – quote that verbatim).
- Use action verbs and NOT state of being verbs as much as possible in all your sentences (a limited use of these: am, is, are, be, being, been)
- Check the spelling of all characters' names.
- Check the spelling of all the Archetypes you have included.
- Capitalize each of the Archetypes you have listed, for example, The Fall.
- Check your punctuation especially commas and placement of those.
- Check your grammar especially watching for faulty pronoun references and correct those.
- Italicize *The Lion King* when you type it.
- Type a proper MLA heading on your essay in the left-hand corner of the top of your essay and double space the lines --see this link from Purdue University: <https://owl.english.purdue.edu/owl/resource/747/01>

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- Write a meaningful title that is centered below the MLA heading. (Example from Clarie H: An Archetypal Analysis about Simba (or change the name Simba to Scar if you are writing about Scar)
- Do not write your thesis statement in a separate paragraph; let the thesis be the first sentence of Body 1 and then continue that body paragraph.
- Create a folder in your M Drive that will be designated for all our 6 TWSA's for this academic year. Folder name: **TWSA English 8**
- Save your draft to your M Drive. Go to this address: <https://my.hpsid.org/>
- Once you make revisions and have the actual final draft, resave the draft to your M Drive.

IF YOU ARE ABSENT ON FRIDAY, also label these aspects in your essay:

- **Label** one of each sentence type in each paragraph (S, CD, and CX). Write either an S, CD, OR CX in the margin beside an example of each of those sentence types in each of your paragraphs.
- **Label** one of your best adjectives. Circle the word and write ADJ above it.
- **Label** one of your best adverbs. Circle the word and write ADV above it.
- **Label** one example of parallel structure. Write “Par. Struc.” In the margin beside the sentence with the parallel structure.
- **Label** one example of pronoun agreement. Circle the pronoun and draw an arrow to the pronoun’s antecedent.
- **Label** all vocabulary words by highlighting each one.
