1. **Notice to all athletes:** A clearance form will not be available until the following day for any athletic physical forms turned in after school. Get your forms turned in before school, brunch or lunch. No forms will be accepted during class time. Be sure to pick up your sports clearance form at the Activity Window before reporting to practice. Pick up clearance forms before school, during brunch or lunch, don't wait until after school!
