Presbyterian Pan American School is a Christian college preparatory school that educates and empowers young adults for leadership in the global community. It is a four-year, fully accredited high school with an additional faith-based curriculum. Pan American is one of the seven racial/ethnic mission schools of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) that is also affiliated by covenant agreement with Synod of the Sun.

The school is located on a 670-acre working ranch five miles south of Kingsville, Texas. This year's enrollment brought approximately 160 students to campus from seven countries. These students come with diverse backgrounds, which prepare them to live in an ever-changing world. Pan American credits its success to a three-part emphasis on academics, mandatory work program and Christian spiritual development.

In May 2012, Presbyterian Pan American School celebrated its Centennial. In May 2014, just two years later, 56 seniors received their diplomas, representing the largest class in the school's 100-year history. And every year 100% of their graduates are accepted into colleges or universities in the United States or their home countries.

Since 92% of the student body receives financial assistance to attend, the school is deeply grateful for gifts to their Scholarship Fund. Through the prayers and generosity of individuals and churches, Presbyterian Pan American School will continue its mission to prepare Christian young people for the challenges of leadership in the world of tomorrow.
