

Ecological Relationships

Mutualism (+ +): a relationship between two kinds of organisms that benefits both

Commensalism (+ 0): a relationship between two kinds of organisms that benefits one without harming the other

Parasitism (+ -): a relationship in which one kind of organism lives in or on another organism and harms that organism

Competition (+ -): when two or more organisms compete for same food or habitat

Predation (+ - death): when an animal (predator) hunts for its food (prey)
