



POLICY: STUDENT REPRESENTATIVES TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors has created non-voting advisory board positions for two students, one traditional high school student and one alternative program high school student. The representatives can be either a junior or senior. The students will attend regular school board evening business meetings, designated portions of retreats and other pre-determined meetings/events. The role of the student representatives will be to:

1. Provide student insight and perspective to the Board of Directors and district administration;
2. Serve as liaisons to the students of West Valley schools through established student government and communications networks; and
3. Report to students about the work of the school district and the Board of Directors.

The student representatives will be bound by all applicable rules and regulations pertaining to the elected board members. The student representatives will participate in board discussions but will not have the right to make motions, vote, hold board offices, or attend executive sessions.
