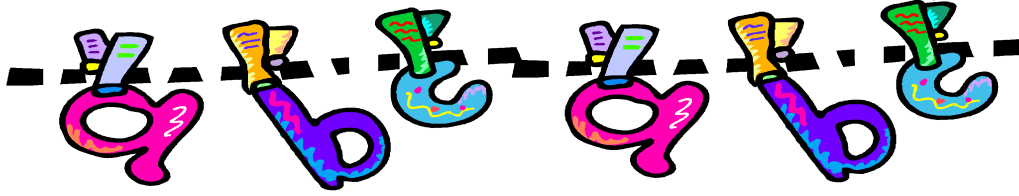


# Speller's Choice Menu



**Directions:** You may choose activities from the menu below to help you study your spelling words. Each activity is worth a given amount of points. You can choose any combination of activities you want, but you need 100 points by the end of the week. You can do extra activities to help you study, but the maximum grade you can receive is 100. You can also repeat any activities you want. All Speller's Choice activities and points sheets are due Friday morning.

## 5 points

### Top Five

Choose the 5 hardest words on the spelling list. Write them 5 times each.

### Copy Cat

Copy your entire list of spelling words in your neatest cursive handwriting.

## 10 points

### Rainbow Words

Write a spelling word with a colorful marker or crayon. Trace back over the letters with a different color. Repeat with all of your words.

## 15 points

### Cheer Your Words

Pretend you are a cheerleader and cheer out your words (and spell them too!) to an adult. Have someone write a note and sign their name to say they listened to you cheer your words!

### Sign Your Words

Use sign language to sign your words to an adult. Have someone write a note and sign their name saying they watched you.

### Be the Teacher

Write your words using chalk. You can write them on a chalkboard at home, on a dark piece of construction paper, or even on your driveway. Have someone write a note and sign their name saying they saw your chalk words.

## 20 points

### 3 Times Each

Write each spelling word three times.

### Friendly Words

Write two words that share a letter so they are touching!

Example:

teach  
m  
p

### Other Handed

If you are right handed, write your words with your left hand! If you are left handed, write your words with your right hand!

## 25 points

### Computer Fun

Use your computer to type your words. Use different fonts and make it look really fun! Be sure you print it out and bring it to school!

### Pyramid Words

Write your words adding one letter at a time. The result will be a pyramid shape of words!

Example: **star**

s  
st  
sta  
star

### Disappearing Words

Write each word, then write it again but leave ONE letter out...then write it again and leave TWO letters out... then THREE... until your word has disappeared!

Example: **cowboy**  
cowboy \_owboy \_\_wboy  
\_\_boy \_\_\_\_oy \_\_\_\_\_  
\_\_\_\_\_

## 30 points

### Secret Agent Words

Number the alphabet from 1-26 (A=1, B=2, C=3, and so on...), then change each of your words into its secret code number! Please write the word with its code next to it!

### Spelling City

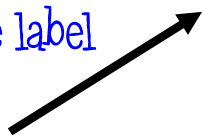
