Table 1. This chart shows how Elementary, K-8 schools, Middle Schools, and High Schools are linked under the proposed school attendance boundaries. Reading across each row shows where students would attend, from Elementary or K8 schools, to Middle School, and High School. In the future, some elementary schools may need to be converted from K-5 to K-6 sites, depending on growth, attendance, and available classroom space. Only Ronald Reagan Elementary is proposed to convert from a K-5 to K-6 in 2015-16. In the future, two Middle Schools (Terra Cotta MS and David A. Brown MS) could become 7-8 sites as more K-5 schools are converted to K-6 schools. The proposed school boundaries will not affect existing High School boundaries. The end result allows flexibility for future growth without the expense of constructing a new Middle School. Future Elementary Schools (Alberhill and Wasson Canyon) are also shown on this chart, though they are not likely to be constructed or needed for several more years.
