### Things to know

3. Work missed due to absence must be made up. It is the **student's responsibility** to find out what was missed, get the materials, and turn in the work for credit.
4. All work done in class must be neat! Work that is illegible will be returned without being graded. It may be redone and resubmitted. However, only partial credit will be given.
5. **All work must be the student's own work.** Students caught copying another student's answers will be referred to the SSRA and earn a zero for that assignment.

### Grading

Each assignment will be worth a predetermined number of points. Longer, more complex assignments will be worth more points than a simple homework assignment. Letter grades are determined by finding the percentage of points earned compared to the number of points assigned.

100-90% = A

79-70% = C

59% or lower = F

89-80% = B

69-60% = D
