

Relations with Community Organizations

The Board recognized that many organizations and public agencies in the community are concerned with and contribute to public education and the betterment of the community through their activities and programs. It will work cooperatively with these groups in activities that enhance community life.

Whenever feasible and possible, the district will permit the use of its buildings and grounds for activities such as recreational programs, health clinics, conventions, adult education programs, extension courses, and similar purposes.

It will also work cooperatively with city and county agencies in planning and development for the area.

Although the Board supports and approves of drives to raise funds for service organizations and community purposes, it is not at liberty to donate district funds. District funds may be used only for purposes of public education.
