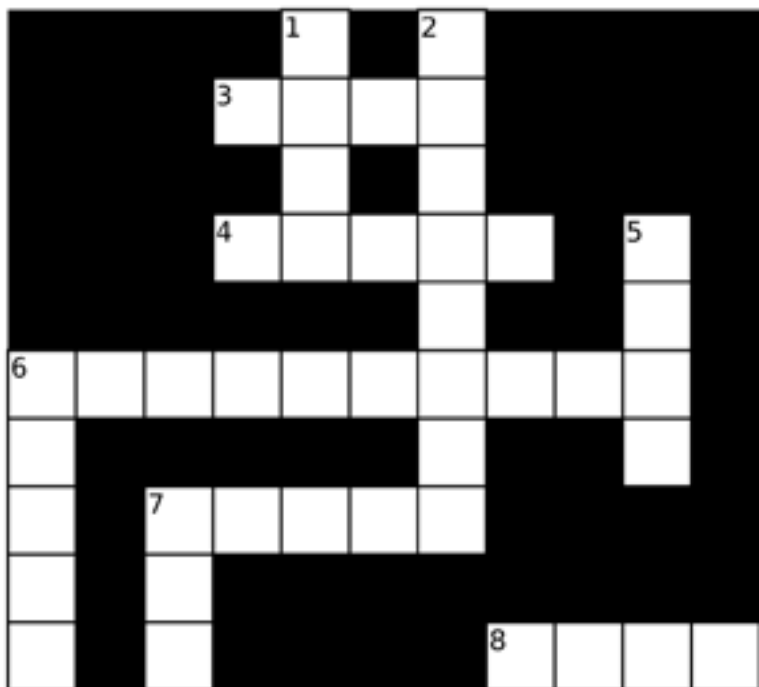

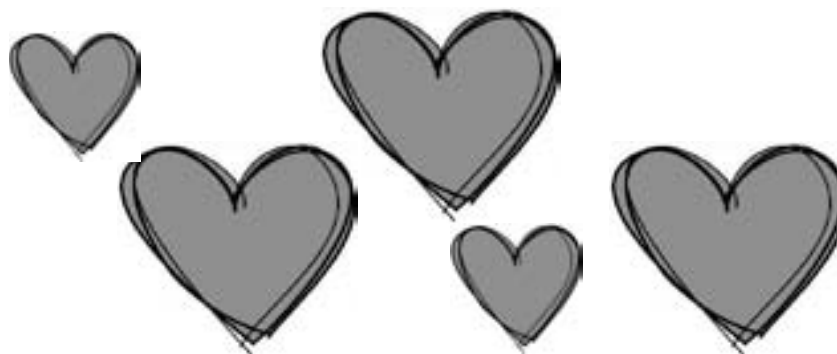

Abbie & Brock



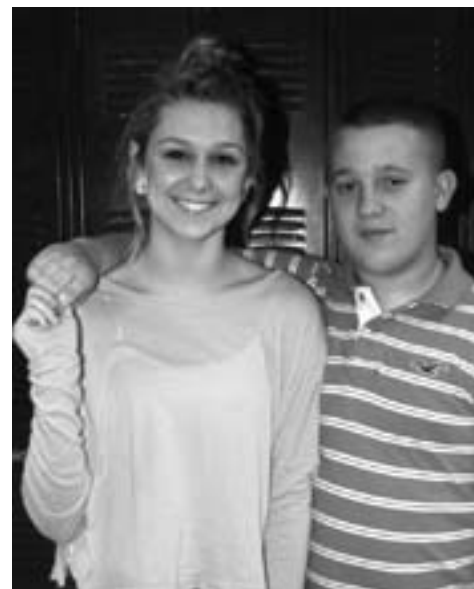

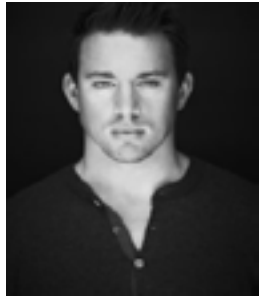
SUGA MAMA: Don't make your date pay for everything. Be a gentleman and treat her like a lady.
