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<u>Instruction</u>

Evaluation of Consolidated Programs

1. Purpose and Scope:

- A. To provide a framework for comprehensive evaluation of the consolidated programs on an annual basis in order to maintain effective, high quality programs for all students, and to provide for annual reporting to the Governing Board.
- B. Consolidated Programs encompass ESEA Title I, ESEA Title VI Innovative Programs, School Improvement Programs, Programs for English Language Learners, SB 1882 Professional Development.

2. Regulation

- A. The Educational Services Division shall provide sites annually with the evaluation criteria for each program as approved by the Board and shall assist sites in accessing any relevant data that is collected at the district level.
- B. If desired, each school site may adopt additional evaluation criteria to meet their unique needs.
- C. By November 1 of the succeeding school year, each site that operates any of the specified programs shall:
 - 1) Gather all data specified by the evaluation criteria for each program;
 - 2) Prepare an analysis of the program effectiveness, based on the relevant data;
 - 3) Present the completed analysis of program effectiveness to School Site Council for consideration during the annual review of the School Plan;
 - 4) Submit the data and completed analysis to the Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services or designee for presentation to the Governing Board.
