In the weeks and months ahead, we will be focusing on the following five areas in order to move our school from **achieving** to **excelling** on the Superintendent's Performance Framework.

- Positive Behavior Intervention and Support** - We've already formed a committee whose members will look at classroom management as well as the implementation of restorative justice on our campus.
- Common Core in the Classroom** - The School Leadership Team (SLT) will spearhead our implementation of the Common Core and will help determine the focus standards for each subject area.
- Authentic Assessments** - Another job for the SLT. The task will also be to ensure that we're ready as a school for the SBAC.
- Project-Based Learning** - Part of sustaining what we started in the MSAP grant. We will seek to continue finding ways to engage students through technique, research-based strategies and sound pedagogy.
- Technology Integration** - We're proceeding at a rapid pace communicating through the Google environment, Edmodo and by other digital means. We're also still purchasing new technology while trying to figure out ways of maintaining the technology we have.

Focusing on these five areas, being diligent about our attendance practices, and coming together to help our LTELs and all other students do their best will almost certainly result in positive movement. Onward.
