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VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR LOCAL CONTROL ADVISORY COMMITTEE Deadline: Monday, November 4, 2013

Pleasanton, California– Pleasanton Unified School District is forming a Local Control Advisory Committee. The Advisory Committee members' responsibility is to advise the Board and the Superintendent about supporting the District Strategic Plan with resources from our Local Control Funding Formula. As indicated in Board Policy 1220, The Board shall establish citizen advisory committees to strengthen the effectiveness of district and school operations, or to enhance student learning.

The members of the Local Control Advisory Committee will serve a two-year-term. The membership of the committee should reflect the diversity of the community and the student body. The Governing Board is seeking up to eight (8) community members and one (1) high school student to serve on its Local Control Advisory Committee. The members of the Advisory Committee will be selected from those who apply for the position by filling out an application and submitting it to the Superintendent by the due date.
