TECHNOLOGY PROTECTION PROGRAM FORM

The Ellsworth School Department (ESD) Board (ESDB) offers a Technology Protection Program (TPP) that provides financial protection for parents for “non-warranty/non-misuse” technology repairs.

Parents have the option to participate in this optional TPP provided by the ESDB.

The TPP covers all non-warranty damage that is not determined to be vandalism, negligence, misuse and/or intentional damage (misuse) by an Apple Certified Macintosh Technician (ACMT).

Under the TPP, parents are responsible for a “school year” program fee of \$35, with a \$50 deductible fee for each occurrence of non-warranty damage.

Program Fee: \$35.00 per year

Incident Fee: \$50.00 for each incident not covered by warranty.

(For example, if your son/daughter has a broken screen determined not to be misuse, if you are enrolled in the TPP, payment due would be the \$50.00 incident fee, versus \$305.95, the actual cost of a screen replacement)

Cleaning Fee: If a technology item is returned with stickers or decals, etc., a \$10 fee will be billed.

Sample costs of common Technology Repairs: Computer Replacement \$1200, Logic Board Replacement \$749, Computer Screen Replacement Cost: \$305.95, Hard Drive \$169, CD Drive \$149, Kindle Replacement \$150, Keyboard and Plastics \$178, Adapters \$72.

NOTE: “Parent” refers to a parent and/or legal Guardian.

Please enroll my son/daughter in the Technology Protection Program (TPP). I understand the program fee is \$35 per year. I agree that I/we will be responsible for \$50 incident fee for each occurrence of damage requiring repair. I also understand that if damage is determined to be misuse, I am responsible for the entire cost of the repair.
